It is a document that contains all information about how to keep children safe and protected. It will help all adults understand their role and responsibilities when working with you.

What is Safeguarding?


Child Safeguarding means that all children have the right to be protected from harm and to be treated with respect.

This policy helps create a safe environment for children, both during our activities and online, so they can be involved, where their ideas, thoughts, feelings and recommendations will be heard and taken into account, an environment where you can freely and genuinely participate and learn.

Important definitions you must know




Child

A child is any person that is under 18 years old.

Child abuse

Child abuse is any form of physical, mental, emotional, or sexual mistreatment that causes actual or potential harm to your physical, mental, and emotional wellbeing.



Physical violence

is, for example, when someone hits you or pushes you.

Mental and emotional violence

is when someone yells at you or says mean things that make you upset.

Sexual violence

is when someone touches you inappropriately or in a way that makes you uncomfortable.

How does Arigatou International safeguard children ?


Arigatou International makes sure that children are protected by training all the adults who lead our activities with children. Everyone who works with Arigatou International learns about children's rights and child safeguarding.

They understand the importance of safeguarding and are prepared to lead our programs and activities.

Know how to keep children safe and they sign a document to show that they understand their responsibilities.

And they will always put your well-being first.



What are your rights ?

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child lists the rights that help keep you safe. Below you can see some.

You have the right to be protected from any type of violence or abuse.

(Articles 11, 19, 32-38)



You have the right to be protected from discrimination.

(Articles 23, 30)



You have the right to share your ideas and opinions.

(Article 12)

What to do if you feel unsafe ?



Don't be afraid to say something if someone hurts you or if you see a person hurting another child. It is never your fault if someone hurts you.

If someone makes you uncomfortable or harms you, share what happened and talk to an adult that you trust.

They will listen to you and help you.



What to do if someone hurts you ?

If someone hurts you or you see someone hurting, harassing, or mistreating another child while participating in an activity organized by Arigatou International, **talk to an adult from Arigatou International (GNRC) that you trust.** They know what to do and will always help you.

Remember that it is never your fault if someone hurts you and that you have the right to be protected.



Online Safeguarding


Sometimes people are mean to each other online and use the internet to hurt or bully children. Arigatou International works to protect your safety and privacy online.

You have the right to be protected online!




- Arigatou International will never misuse your name, pictures, videos, materials you've produced, or information about you, and will always respect your privacy.
- We will never use your information without asking you, your parents or caregivers first, and unless you say it is allowed.
- If it's ok for Arigatou International to use your pictures or videos, you and your guardian have the right to know where and how your images will be used.

Your information will always be respected and will never be used if it causes any risks or concerns for you and your family.

Children's rights and needs are our first priority! We want to see you flourish, feeling happy, safe and encouraged to reach your full potential with other children from all around the world!




All members of Arigatou International promise to...

without being afraid to be judged by who you are, where you come from, what you believe, or by your ideas!


